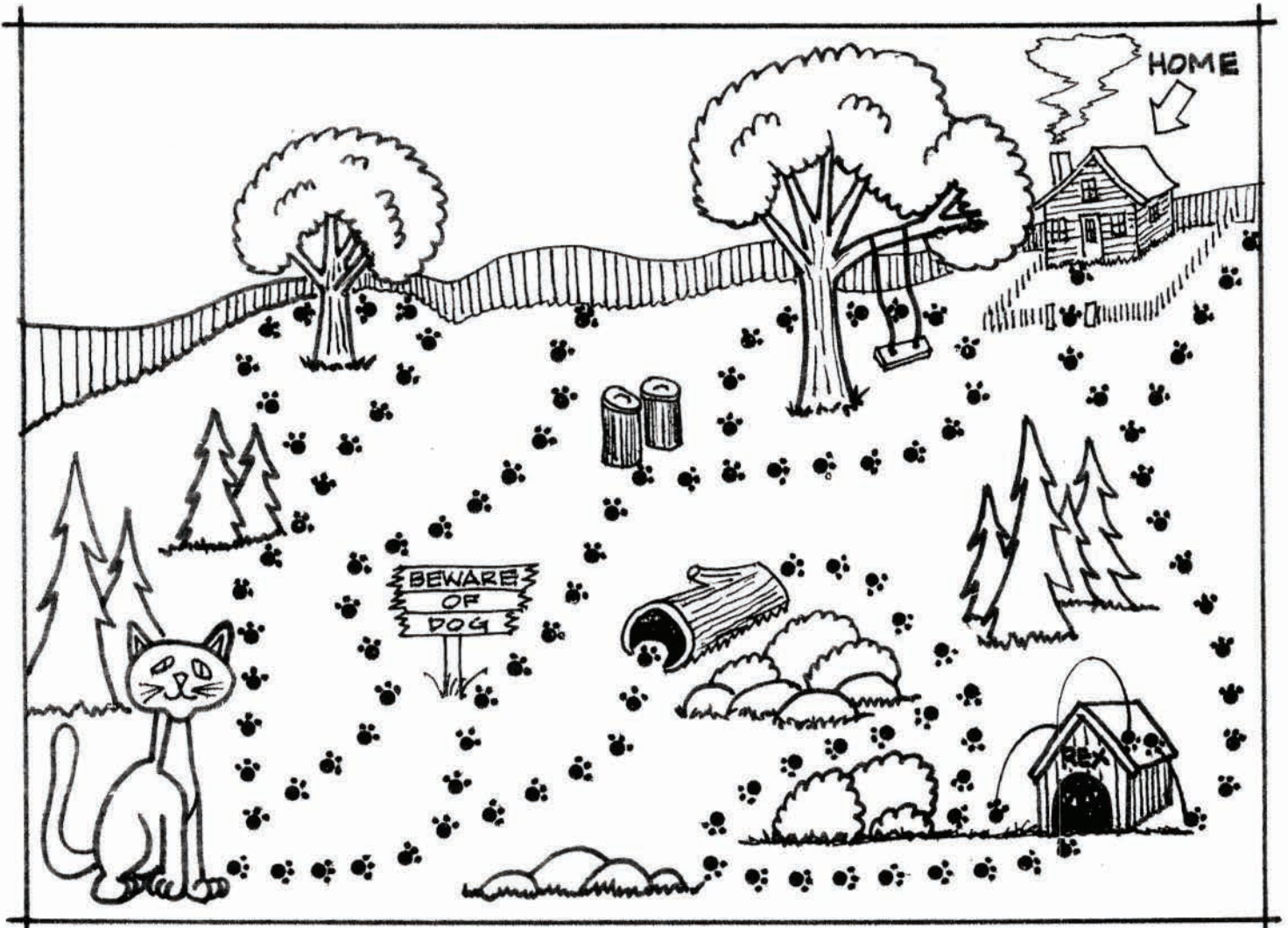
I promise to give my kitty cat food and water every day.

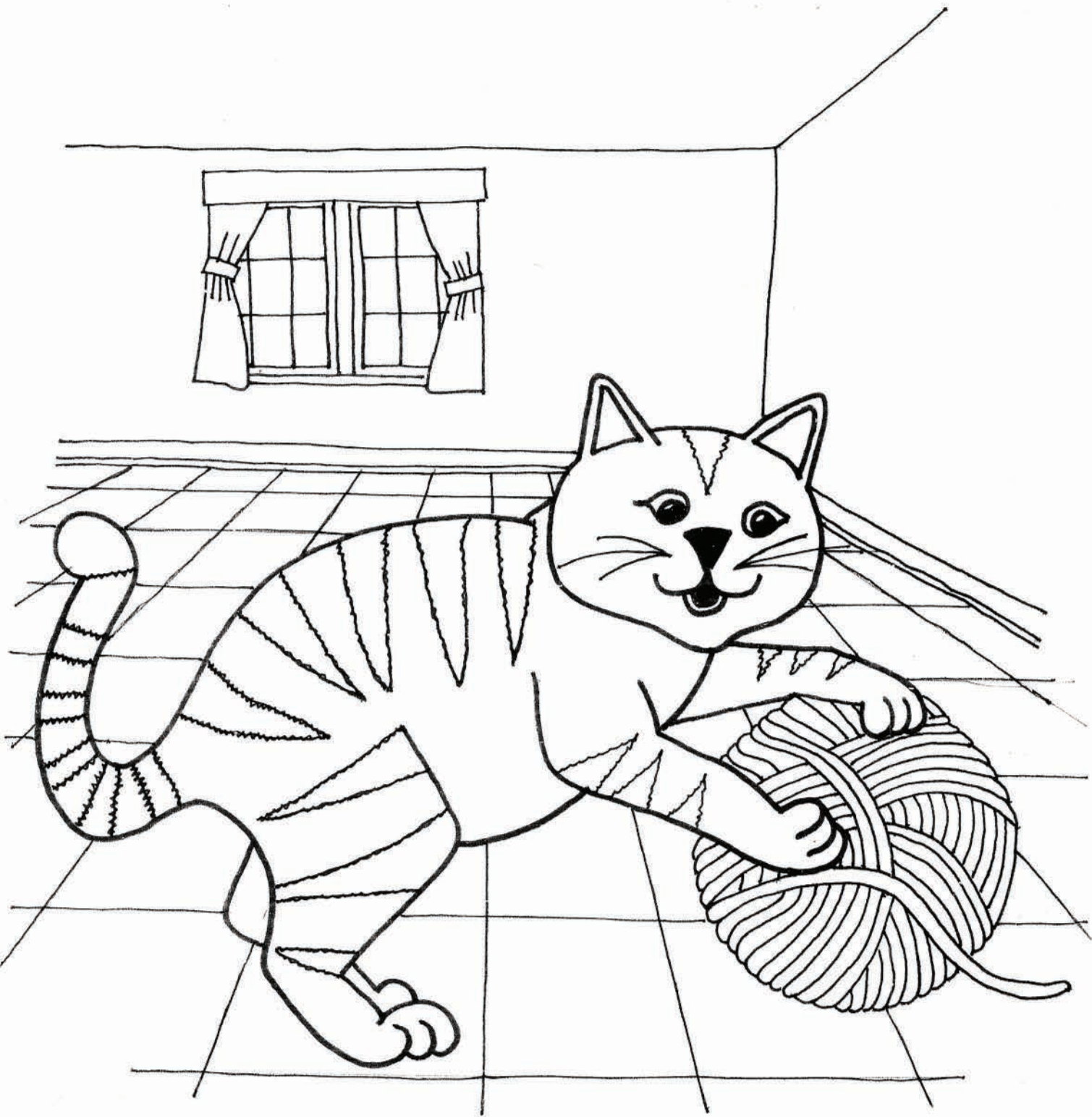


I promise to give my kitty a soft bed or pillow to sleep on.

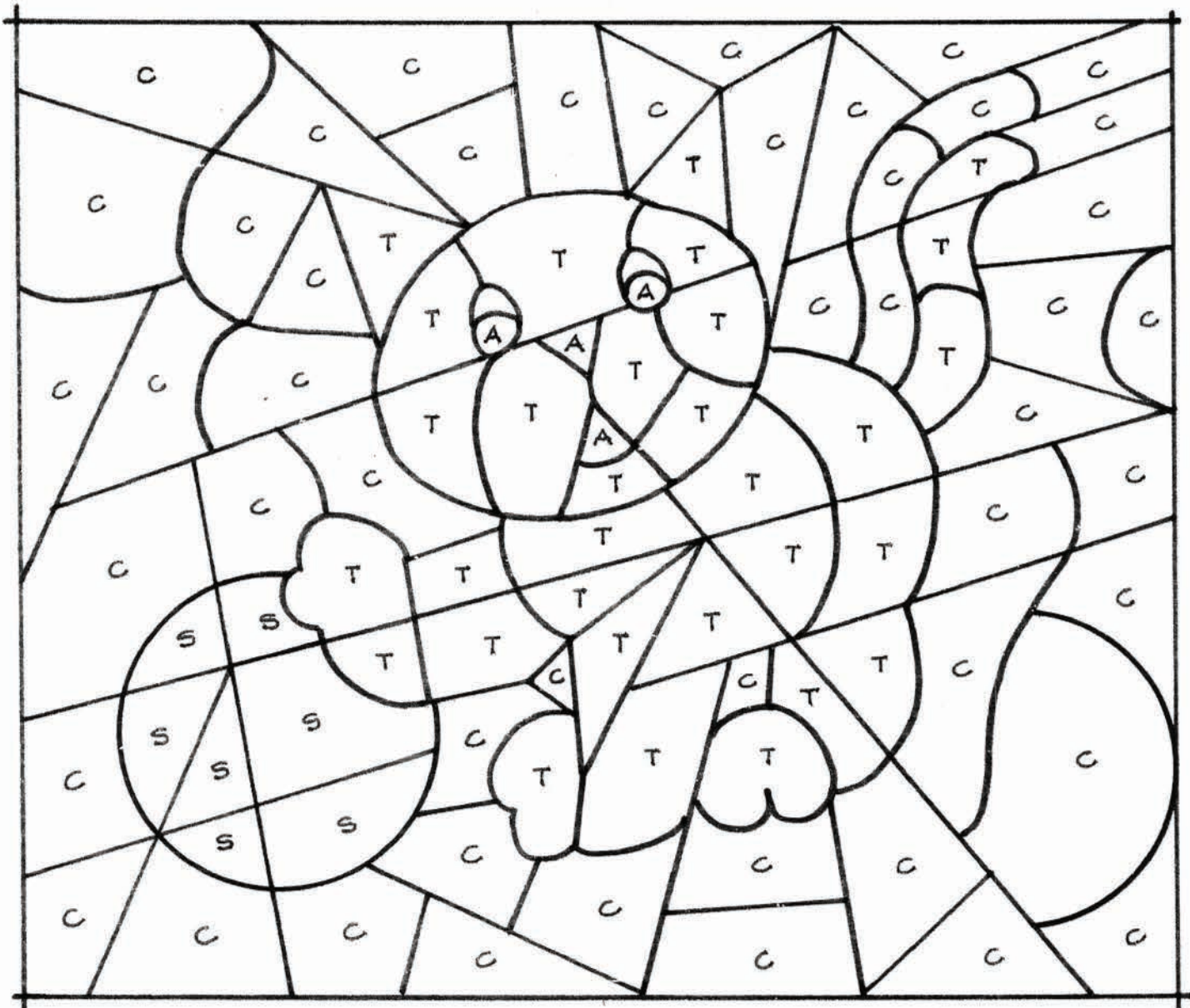
HELP KITTY FIND HER WAY HOME

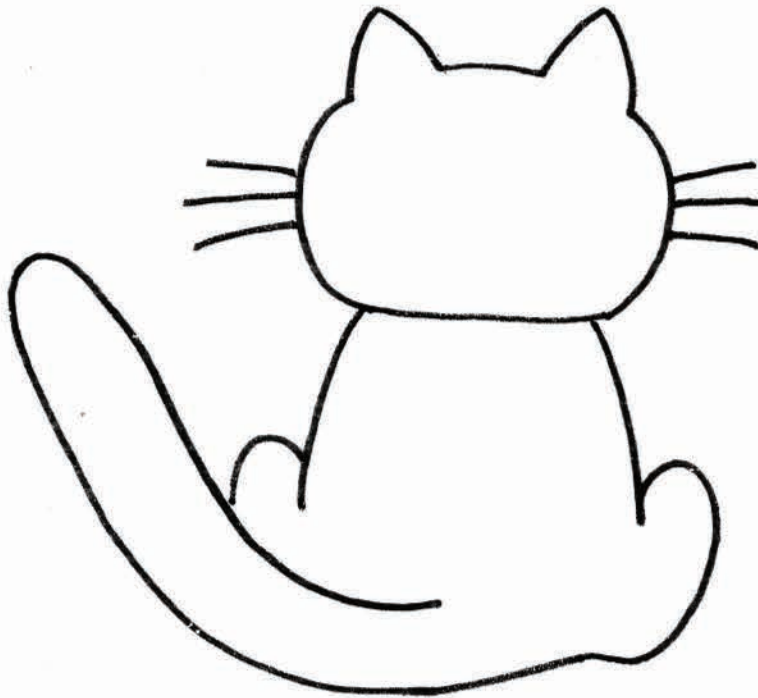

The Greater New Haven Cat Project, Inc. (GNHCP) is a non-profit organization formed in 1996 working to alleviate the unnecessary suffering of abandoned, neglected and abused cats through spaying, neutering and public education.

GNHCP works to:

- rescue and socialize feral kittens (unsocialized cats born in the wild)
- rescue adult stray cats and humanely trap adult feral cats
- provide basic veterinary care, including spaying and neutering
- find homes for rescued cats and kittens
- return neutered feral cats to original maintained colonies
- provide information and resources about the importance of spaying and neutering.
